

Public Discussion of Proposed West Yellowstone Airport Project

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT), Aeronautics Division is sponsoring an open house to review the proposed improvements and environmental process for the Yellowstone Airport terminal project.

The open house will be held in West Yellowstone on Monday, September 16th, at 6:00 p.m. at the Yellowstone Airport ARFF Building, (Fire Station) 629 Yellowstone Airport Road

FAA Project team members will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed project will entail the construction of a new terminal at the airport, demolition of the existing terminal, installation of a new beacon, expansion of on airport road/parking lot improvements, rehabilitation of the airport access road, and extension of the Town of West Yellowstone water/sewer to airport facilities.
